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Purpose of the Equity Form

The Equity Supplement Form enables applicants to the Bachelor of Social Work program to voluntarily self-identify as members of communities or groups that have and continue to historically, persistently and/or systematically face barriers or discrimination in accessing education in the field of social work. The School of Social Work uses this form in order to promote the principles of equity and diversity in the admission process and ensure that the program reflects society's diverse perspectives and experiences.

Identifying as one or more of the groups identified will positively impact the applicant's admission. Applicants can self-identify with one or more groups or none at all.
